HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO OFFER STUDENTS FROM CERTAIN PACIFIC ISLAND NATIONS A REDUCED TUITION RATE EQUIVALENT TO THE RESIDENT TUITION RATE.

1 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii seeks to extend 2 educational opportunities to residents of Hawaii and the Asia-3 Pacific region, especially those of Native Hawaiian, Pacific 4 Islander, and other indigenous ancestry; and 5

6 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii currently offers students 7 from certain Pacific Island districts, commonwealths, 8 territories, or insular jurisdictions, states, or nations which 9 provide no public higher education institution granting 10 baccalaureate degrees a reduced tuition rate equivalent to one 11 hundred and fifty per cent of the resident tuition rate; and 12

WHEREAS, the list of Pacific Island jurisdictions that qualify for the tuition rate equivalent to one hundred and fifty per cent of the resident tuition rate is updated and distributed by the University President's Office and currently includes American Samoa, Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas, Cook Islands, Futuna, Kiribati, Nauru, Niue, Solomon Islands, Tokelau, Tonga, Tuvalu, Vanuatu, and Wallis; and

21 WHEREAS, members of the Freely Associated States are 22 offered even further reduced tuition rates equivalent to one 23 hundred per cent of the resident tuition rate, including the 24 Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI), Federated States of 25 Micronesia (FSM), and the Republic of Palau; and 26

WHEREAS, expanding this reduced tuition rate to include a
more comprehensive list of Pacific Island neighbors would allow
for even more accessible learning opportunities and higher rates
of cross-cultural exchange and collaboration; now, therefore,

1 2 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 3 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the Senate concurring, the University of Hawaii is 4 urged to offer students from certain Pacific Island districts, 5 commonwealths, territories, or insular jurisdictions, states, or 6 7 nations which provide no public higher education institution 8 granting baccalaureate degrees a reduced tuition rate equivalent 9 to one hundred per cent of the resident tuition rate; and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 11 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 12 ten Ward University of Hawaii System. 13 14 15 16
