HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING HAWAI'I COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO CONSIDER RESIDENTIAL, HOTEL, AND OTHER LAND USES FOR THE KAKAAKO MAKAI AREA.

1 2 3 4	WHEREAS, the Hawai'i Community Development Authority (HCDA) intends to update the Kaka'ako Community Development District Makai Area master plan and administrative rules in 2025: and
5 6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, the planning process will include community and stakeholder engagement, infrastructure assessment, traffic impact analysis, soil contamination assessment, sea level rise analysis, and cultural and historical analysis; and
10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 23 24 25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, although the Makai area plan was updated in 2023, it did not contemplate residential, hotel and other uses, nor did it consider soil and geotechnical analysis, cultural and historical analysis, view plan impact of potentially higher densities, and sea level rise on building design and siting; and WHEREAS, in updating the Makai Area Master Plan, the HCDA should include a robust community and stakeholder engagement process, infrastructure assessment, traffic impact analysis, soil contamination assessment, sea level rise analysis, and cultural and historical analysis, among other planning consideration; and WHEREAS, the State continues to suffer from a shortage of affordable housing with fewer families able to afford to buy or rent a home in the State, while Native Hawaiians suffer disproportionately from this lack of affordable housing; now, therefore,



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BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the HCDA, in conjunction with the updating of the Kaka'ako Community Development District Makai Area Master Plan, is authorized to:

Consult with the Hawaii Housing Finance and 7 (1)Development Corporation, Office of Hawaiian Affairs, Office of 8 Hawaiian Affairs, Department of Planning and Permitting of the 9 City and County of Honolulu, University of Hawaii at Manoa John 10 A. Burns School of Medicine, Department of Transportation, 11 Department of Business Economic Development and Tourism, 12 13 Department of Education, and The Kakaako Makai Community Planning Advisory Council; and 14

Conduct a study to consider residential, hotel, and 16 (2)other land uses in the Kakaako Makai Area which shall include a 17 public hearing before submitting the study to the Legislature. 18 Notice of the public hearing shall be published at least thirty 19 days prior to the hearing and shall include: (a) the date, time, 20 and place of the hearing; (b) a statement of the topic of the 21 hearing; and (c) a description of where, when, and how the study 22 may be viewed by the public. All interested persons may submit 23 data or opinions, orally or in writing, in conjunction with the 24 hearing. 25

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the HCDA shall submit its study 28 considering residential, hotel, and other land uses for the 29 Kakaako Makai Area to the Legislature no later than twenty days 30 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2026; and 31
