HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO REVIEW AND AUDIT THE CURRENT PERMITTING, INSPECTION, AND PENALTY PROCESS FOR MONSTER HOMES, AND TO IDENTIFY AND RECOMMEND IMPROVEMENTS TO ADDRESS ASSOCIATED ISSUES.

WHEREAS, "monster homes" are oversized residential 1 structures that often circumvent existing zoning laws, approved 2 building plans, and neighborhood specifications; and 3 4 WHEREAS, monster homes negatively impact community 5 character, increase neighborhood congestion, and may pose health 6 7 and safety risks due to overcapacity and noncompliance with building codes; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the current permitting, inspection, and penalty 10 processes have been insufficient to deter violations and ensure 11 compliance, leading to continued instances of unauthorized 12 construction and misuse; and 13 14 WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to uphold zoning 15 laws, enforce building codes, and protect the integrity of 16 Honolulu's neighborhoods; now, therefore, 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 19 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 20 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor of the City and 21 County of Honolulu is requested to review and audit the current 22 permitting, inspection, and penalty processes as they relate to 23 monster homes; and 24 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor of the City and County of Honolulu is requested to recommend: 27 28
