HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO CALL A CONVENTION FOR PROPOSING AMENDMENTS PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V OF THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION LIMITED TO PROPOSING AMENDMENTS THAT IMPOSE FISCAL RESTRAINTS ON THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, LIMIT THE POWER AND JURISDICTION OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, AND LIMIT THE TERMS OF OFFICE FOR ITS OFFICIALS AND MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.

1 WHEREAS, executive orders by the President of the United 2 States have become a vehicle through which the President may 3 overstep the limits of the President's constitutional authority; 4 and 5

6 WHEREAS, the concentration of power at the federal level
7 has had the effect of making federal officials less responsive
8 to the will of the people and more readily influenced by
9 lobbyists, wealthy corporations, and special interests in
10 Washington, D.C.; and

12 WHEREAS, much of federal law is now created by federal 13 bureaucrats who were never elected by the people and have no 14 accountability to the people whatsoever; and 15

16 WHEREAS, policy decisions made at the state level tend to 17 be more responsive to the needs and desires of the people; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the federal government has accumulated a crushing 20 national debt through improper and imprudent spending; and 21

22 WHEREAS, Hawaii has historically used federal funds for 23 economic development that is subject to federal fiscal 24 restraints; and 25

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WHEREAS, the federal government has invaded the legitimate 1 2 roles of the states through the manipulative process of federal mandates, many of which are unfunded to a great extent; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the states have the ability to restore the 5 6 responsiveness of government to the people and to restrain 7 abuses of federal power by proposing amendments to the 8 Constitution of the United States through a limited convention of the states under article V of the United States Constitution; 9 10 now, therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 13 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that this body urges and applies 14 to Congress under the provisions of article V of the United 15 16 States Constitution to call for a convention of the states, limited to proposing amendments to the United States 17 Constitution that impose fiscal restraints on the federal 18 19 government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and limit the terms of office for its officials and 20 members of Congress; subject however to the following 21 reservations, understandings, and declarations: 22 23 An application to the United States Congress to call 24 (1)25 an amendment convention of the states pursuant to article V of the United States Constitution confers no 26 27 power to Congress other than the power to call such a convention, rather, the power of Congress to exercise 28 this ministerial duty consists solely of the authority 29 to name a reasonable time and place for the initial 30 meeting of a convention; 31 32 (2) Congress shall perform its ministerial duty of calling 33 an amendment convention of the states only upon the 34 receipt of applications for an amendment convention 35 for substantially the same purpose as this application 36 37 from two-thirds of the legislatures of the several states; 38 39 40 (3) Congress shall not have the power or authority to determine any rules for the governing of an amendment 41 convention of the states pursuant to article V of the 42

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Majority Leader and Secretary of the United States Senate, Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, members of Hawaii's congressional delegation, and presiding officers of each of the legislative houses in each of the other forty-nine states.
