HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF REGENTS TO ESTABLISH A BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII MAUI CAMPUS.

1 WHEREAS, the demand for healthcare services in the County 2 of Maui is increasing due to a growing and aging population; and 3 4 WHEREAS, there is a pressing need for highly qualified 5 nursing professionals to meet the healthcare needs of the community; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii Maui College currently offers a Practical Nurse Certificate of Achievement and an 9 Associate in Science in Nursing degree, which prepare students 10 for entry-level nursing positions; and 11 12 WHEREAS, students who complete the Associate in Science in 13 14 Nursing Program have the opportunity to earn a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree through the University of Hawaii at 15 Manoa, commonly known as the "Hawaii Statewide Nursing 16 Consortium"; and 17 18 WHEREAS, since 2012, less than twenty percent of the 19 Associate in Science in Nursing graduates have enrolled and 20 completed the Hawaii Statewide Nursing Consortium, due to a 21 majority of those individuals being in the Maui nursing 22 workforce; and 23 24 WHEREAS, an estimated twenty percent of the Maui Associate 25 in Science in Nursing Program graduates have enrolled in an 26 out-of-state online Bachelor of Science in Nursing program; and 27 28 WHEREAS, establishing a dedicated Bachelor of Science in 29 30 Nursing program at the University of Hawaii Maui College will provide Maui residents with an uninterrupted pathway for more 31

1 advanced nursing knowledge along with greater advancement 2 opportunities; and 3 4 WHEREAS, while Oahu nursing schools have been unable to 5 expand enrollment due to a lack of available clinical placements, Maui healthcare facilities have ample available 6 7 clinical placements for Maui nursing students to gain real-world 8 experience that is necessary to earn their degrees; now, 9 therefore, 10 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 12 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the University of Hawaii 13 President and Board of Regents are urged to establish a Bachelor 14 15 of Science in Nursing program at the University of Hawaii Maui 16 College; and 17 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature affirms the importance of a Bachelor of Science in Nursing program at the 19 20 University of Hawaii Maui College and recognizes that additional nurse graduates would help to address the State's nurse 21 shortage; and 22 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Hawaii Board 25 of Regents is requested to allocate appropriate resources and 26 support to develop and implement the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program, including faculty recruitment, curriculum 27 28 development, and necessary facilities; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 31 32 University of Hawaii Board of Regents, the President of the University of Hawaii System, and the Chancellor of the 33 University of Hawaii Maui College. 34 35 36 37 OFFERED BY: MAR 0 6 2025
