HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Education is responsible for the 1 repair and maintenance of 4,425 buildings statewide, which is 2 more than twenty million square feet of space; and 3 4 WHEREAS, this is a time-consuming and financially-draining 5 task as approximately twenty percent of Hawaii's public schools 6 are more than one hundred years old, and the average age of 7 school buildings in the State is seventy-two years; and 8 9 WHEREAS, properly repairing and maintaining public school 10 buildings is necessary for the safety of Hawaii's students and 11 teachers; and 12 13 WHEREAS, as of January 2024, the Department of Education 14 had over \$2 billion in unspent capital improvement program funds 15 at school facilities; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Department of Education received nearly \$1 18 billion in the 2021-2023 fiscal biennium for capital improvement 19 project appropriations; and 20 21 WHEREAS, fiscal accountability and oversight are critical 22 to ensure proper spending by the Department of Education while 23 providing Hawaii's students with safe learning environments; and 24 25 WHEREAS, this body finds that it is necessary to increase 26 transparency and disciplined and timely spending of capital 27 improvement program funds by the Department of Education, as 28 many public school facilities in the State are in need of repair 29 or renovation; and 30 31 WHEREAS, an audit of the Department of Education could help 32 identify any shortcomings in the current distribution of funds 33 and determine any necessary changes to increase the efficiency 34 of the Department of Education's capital improvement repair and 35 maintenance projects; now, therefore, 36



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1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 2 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 3 of 2025, that the Auditor is requested to conduct an audit of 4 the Department of Education's capital improvement projects; and 5 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the audit is requested to examine the Department of Education's finances relating to 8 capital improvement projects since 2021; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the audit is requested to 11 include how the Department of Education expends moneys on 12 capital improvement projects, including the prioritization of 13 projects; and 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 16 submit a report of the findings and recommendations, including 17 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than 18 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 19 2026; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 22 Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and Superintendent of 23 Education. 24 25 26 OFFERED BY: Juishle Chall 27
