HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING KAMEHAMEHA SCHOOLS / BISHOP ESTATE TO PRIORITIZE COMMUNICATION AND TRANSPARENCY WITH THE HAWAII KAI COMMUNITY AMID LEASE EXPIRATIONS OF PROMINENT NEIGHBORHOOD ASSETS AND MAINTAIN THE STATUS QUO IN FUTURE LAND USE DECISIONS.

1 WHEREAS, Kamehameha Schools / Bishop Estate (KSBE) is the largest landowner in Hawaii Kai; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, Hawaii Kai was designed by Henry Kaiser as a 5 community with intentionally planned infrastructure, recreation, and residences, including approximately eighty acres set aside 6 7 for farmers under lease from KSBE; and 8 9 WHEREAS, numerous leases for properties owned by KSBE are 10 soon set to expire, with the future of multiple beloved 11 community assets now uncertain; and 12 13 WHEREAS, in July 2025, KSBE's farm leases in Kamilonui Valley will expire, affecting multiple long-standing community 14 farmers who are in their seventies, make a modest income, and 15 have recently been burdened by a \$10,000 fine passed on to them 16 from KSBE who was fined by the Environmental Protection Agency 17 regarding cesspool conversions, further worsening their 18 financial situation; and 19 20 WHEREAS, in 2028 the leases for land in Hahaione Valley 21 currently home to properties including the Japan-America 22 23 Institute of Management Science (JAIMS) are set to expire, causing concern for what might become of this area and the view 24 plane of the residents in nearby condominiums; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Kai community and elected representatives have made efforts to foster an open dialogue 28 29 with KSBE to ensure community sentiment is taken into account in

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their planning processes and that those interested in the future 1 2 of these properties can stay informed; and 3 WHEREAS, by and large, KSBE has rejected opportunities for 4 5 community discussion, and the vast majority of residents feel an extreme lack of transparency and openness from KSBE's 6 7 representatives for what is to come; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Kai community is very invested in the 10 future of these properties and others with impending KSBE lease expirations and is due a clear line of communication as it comes 11 to what is to occur in their own backyard; now, therefore, 12 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 15 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 16 of 2025, Kamehameha Schools / Bishop Estate is urged to provide regular, informative, and timely updates to the Hawaii Kai 17 18 community regarding properties with expiring leases and plans for future use and possible development; and 19 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED Kamehameha Schools / Bishop Estate is encouraged to maintain the status quo in future land use 22 23 decisions, minimizing impacts to the surrounding community and 24 limiting disruptions to how the present assets are currently utilized; and 25 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to Kamehameha Schools / Bishop 28 Estate's Chief Executive Officer, Senior Asset Manager, Land 29 Asset Manager, and Board of Trustees; Chair of the Hawaii Kai 30 Neighborhood Board; President of the Japan-America Institute of 31 Management Science; Manager of The Oahu Club; and Kamilonui 32 33 Valley Farmers Association. 34 I'm Wend 35 36 OFFERED BY:

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
