HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE PROMOTION AND EXPANSION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU NEIGHBORHOOD SECURITY WATCH PROGRAM.

1 2 3	WHEREAS, the Honolulu Police Department coordinates a neighborhood security watch program; and
3 4 5 6 7	WHEREAS, numerous communities have established neighborhood security watch groups, with approximately twelve thousand residents participating across Oahu; and
8 9 10 11 12	WHEREAS, neighborhood security watch program members and participants receive education on operation identification, residential security inspections, reporting suspicious activity to 911 emergency services, and describing suspects; and
12 13 14 15 16 17	WHEREAS, the neighborhood security watch program is an important tool for improving community security, effective crime deterrence, activating community involvement and integration, and fostering and strengthening neighbor relationships; and
18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, neighborhood security watch groups in participating communities are spearheaded by a volunteer program coordinator who serves as the liaison between the community and police; and
22 23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, the program coordinator works directly with district police officers, designated block captains, and community members; and
27 28 29 30 31	WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu makes available to participants house decals and street signs to show that communities and individual residents are participating in the neighborhood security watch program; and
31 32 33	WHEREAS, neighborhood security watch groups are entirely organized and maintained by community volunteers; and



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1 WHEREAS, the neighborhood security watch program could be 2 even more effective if greater public resources were provided to 3 participating community groups; now, therefore, 4 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 6 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 7 of 2025, that the City and County of Honolulu is requested to 8 9 promote and expand the neighborhood security watch program; and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu 11 is requested to establish a prototype pilot program that 12 provides minimal funding budget allowance for a community or 13 14 communities that have an established and active neighborhood security watch program; and 15 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the pilot program budget allowance is requested to provide to the program coordinator, at 18 minimum, funding for one mailer per home, per quarter, in the 19 selected community or communities, and funding for regular 20 meetings of the neighborhood security watch group or groups; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate Honolulu Police 23 Department division is requested to provide accounting and 24 oversight of the pilot program funding; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, if proven successful, the 27 pilot program is requested to be expanded to other communities; 28 29 and 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 31 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of 32 33 Honolulu; Chief of the Honolulu Police Department; and Chair of 34 the Honolulu City Council. 35 Anner M.
