HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF THE MONEYS APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS PURSUANT TO ACT 279, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII 2022.

WHEREAS, Act 279, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022 ("Act 279"), 1 as amended by Act 125, Session Laws of Hawaii 2024, appropriated 2 \$600,000,000 to eliminate the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands 3 waitlist by providing land and housing to native Hawaiians; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands was 6 authorized to use the appropriated moneys to develop residential 7 lots and housing units, purchase land, provide financial 8 assistance to the waitlisted applicants, and other necessary 9 services; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Act 279 mandates that the Department of Hawaiian 12 Home Lands establish a strategic plan that aligns with the 13 beneficiaries' preferences, as identified in the 2020 14 Beneficiaries Study Applicant Report, with seventy-six percent 15 of beneficiaries preferring a single-family home or a vacant lot 16 for home construction, and sixteen percent preferring rental or 17 rent-to-own options for single-family homes, duplexes, 18 apartments, or townhouses; and 19 20 WHEREAS, as of 2022, the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands 21 waitlist included over 28,700 native Hawaiian beneficiaries, a 22 number that remains relatively unchanged by late 2024 despite 23 the intent of Act 279; and 24 25 WHEREAS, On January 17, 2024, the Department of Hawaiian 26 Home Lands submitted its required Annual Activity Report which 27 stated that the Department encumbered and expended approximately 28 \$193.7 million, with the projected total of 1,489 applicants on 29 the waiting list having been assisted; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the entire appropriation of \$600,000,000 was 32 reportedly attached to projects by early 2025, targeting over 33 seven thousand five hundred homes and lots over the next five 34 35 years; and

1 WHEREAS, as of March 5, 2025, the Department of Hawaiian 2 Home Lands has not submitted its Annual Activity Report to the 3 Legislature, as required by Act 279, to account for the 4 expenditures made for the purposes of Act 279 in the previous 5 fiscal year, and to account for the number of applicants on the 6 waiting list that have been assisted; now, therefore, 7 8 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 9 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 10 of 2025, that the Auditor is requested to conduct an audit on 11 the Department of the Hawaiian Home Lands as related to the 12 moneys allocated to it pursuant to Act 279 and the 2020 13 Beneficiaries Study Applicant Report; and 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 16 Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and the Chairperson of 17 the Hawaiian Homes Commission. 18 19 20 OFFERED BY: 21
