BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

5	homelessn	ess or separately with individual states, the office
7	may enter	into formal agreements with other states:

2		associated with homeless individuals from Hawaii
3		relocating to those states;
4	(2)	For other states to reimburse the costs incurred by
5		Hawaii for homeless individuals from those states
6		relocating to Hawaii;
7	(3)	For mutually agreed upon ethical practices for the
8		treatment of homeless individuals;
9	(4)	For a framework of shared responsibility to address
10		homelessness; and
11	(5)	To allow Hawaii to pursue legal action against another
12		state for violation of the formal agreement.
13	<u>(d)</u>	The office may adopt rules under chapter 91 for
14	purposes	of this section.
15	<u>(e)</u>	For the purposes of this section, "state" includes a
16	territory	of the United States."

9		homelessness, and a summary of any formal agreements	
10		entered into under section 346"	
11	SECT	ION 4. There is appropriated out of the general	
12	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much	
13	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the		
14	same sum o	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year	
15	2026-2027 for the interstate collaboration on homelessness.		
16	The s	sums appropriated shall be expended by the statewide	
17	office on homelessness and housing solutions for the purposes o		
18	this Act.

Report Title:

Interstate Collaboration on Homelessness; Statewide Office on Homelessness and Housing Solutions; Appropriation

Description:

Requires the Statewide Office on Homelessness and Housing Solutions to establish the Interstate Collaboration on Homelessness to discourage sending unsupported homeless individuals to other states and territories. Requires the Statewide Office on Homelessness and Housing Solutions to enter into formal agreements with other states to reimburse costs associated with relocated homeless individuals. Appropriates funds.

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
