A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CULTURE AND ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the aloha order of 2 merit was established to recognize individuals who have made 3 significant contributions and achieved national or international 4 recognition in a field either by a single event or by the 5 totality of work that has been pioneering in that field or 6 outstanding in the long term. The legislature also finds that 7 many exceptional and notable individuals are deserving of 8 recognition specifically for their contributions to Hawaii. 9 While the aloha order of merit honors individuals who have made 10 national and international contributions and achieved recognition, the legislature believes there should be a similar 11 12 program to honor individuals who have made their mark on Hawaii. 13 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish the Hawaii leadership awards program to honor individuals who have 14 15 made considerable and outstanding contributions to Hawaii in 16 their respective fields and serve as inspirations to others.

(11) Profile in courage; and (12) Friend of Hawaii, who have resided in the State for a period of at least seven years; provided that no individual receiving an award pursuant to paragraph (12) shall reside in the State. The governor, lieutenant governor, and members of the (C) Hawaii leadership awards selection committee, or their designees, shall present the awards to awardees annually. No individual shall receive more than one award per category per year. (d) Each awardee shall: (1) Receive a certificate of honor and medal; and (2) Have the awardee's story and a statement of recognition displayed in a conspicuous place for a period of one year; provided that after the year, the awardee's information shall be added to a permanent archival exhibit of awardees, to include those from the Aloha order of merit; provided further that the awardee's information shall be archived within the state archives.
