A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature acknowledges the multitude of
- health and safety issues relating to the illegal use of
- 3 fireworks in Hawaii.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to reduce the penalty for
- fireworks offenses to a civil violation with the intended goal 5
- 6 of achieving more expeditious enforcement of fireworks laws.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 132D-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 8
- 9 "(a) Any person:
- 10 Importing aerial devices, display fireworks, or (1)
- articles pyrotechnic without having a valid license 11
- 12 under section 132D-7 shall be guilty of a class C
- 13 felony;
- 14 (2) Purchasing, possessing, setting off, igniting, or
- 15 discharging aerial devices, display fireworks, or
- 16 articles pyrotechnic without a valid permit under
- 17 sections 132D-10 and 132D-16, or storing, selling, or

1	possessing aerial devices, display fireworks, or
2	articles pyrotechnic without a valid license under
3	section 132D-7, or allowing an individual to possess,
4	set off, ignite, discharge, or otherwise cause to
5	explode any aerial device in violation of section
6	132D-14.5:
7	(A) If the total weight of the aerial devices,
8	display fireworks, or articles pyrotechnic is
9	twenty-five pounds or more, shall be guilty of a
10	class C felony; or
11	(B) If the total weight of the aerial devices,
12	display fireworks, or articles pyrotechnic is
13	less than twenty-five pounds, shall be guilty of
14	a misdemeanor; provided that purchasing,
15	possessing, setting off, igniting, or discharging
16	aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles
17	pyrotechnic without a valid permit under sections
18	132D-10 and 132D-16 shall be a civil violation if
19	the total weight of the aerial devices, display
20	fireworks, or articles pyrotechnic is less than
21	twenty-five pounds. A person issued a civil

2		subject to a fine of \$;
3	(3) Who	o transfers or sells aerial devices, display
4	fi	reworks, or articles pyrotechnic to a person who
5	doe	es not have a valid permit under sections 132D-10
6	and	d 132D-16, shall be guilty of a class C felony; and
7	(4) Who	removes or extracts the pyrotechnic contents from
8	any	y fireworks or articles pyrotechnic and uses the
9	COI	ntents to construct fireworks, articles pyrotechnic,
10	or	a fireworks or articles pyrotechnic related device
11	sha	all be guilty of a misdemeanor."
12	SECTION	3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
13	matured, pena	alties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
14	begun before	its effective date.

16	SECTION	5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
