## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AIRCRAFT RESCUE FIRE FIGHTING UNIT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 261, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- and to read as follows: 3
- 4 "\$261- State aircraft rescue fire fighting unit; chief;
- term limits. (a) The director of transportation may appoint 5
- 6 the chief of the aircraft rescue fire fighting unit of the
- 7 airports division of the department of transportation from a
- 8 list of five qualified candidates submitted for consideration by
- 9 the state fire council, subject to the advice and consent of the
- 10 senate; provided that the director of transportation shall give
- 11 strong consideration and prioritize the five qualified
- 12 candidates submitted by the state fire council.
- 13 (b) Each appointed chief of the aircraft rescue fire
- 14 fighting unit of the airports division of the department of
- 15 transportation shall serve a term of four years. No chief shall
- 16 be appointed to more than two consecutive terms."
- **17** SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
