
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AIRCRAFT RESCUE FIRE FIGHTING UNIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 261, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§261- Hawaii state aircraft rescue fire fighting unit;
5 chief; term limits. (a) The director of transportation may
6 appoint the fire chief of the Hawaii state aircraft rescue fire
7 fighting unit of the airports division of the department of
8 transportation from a list of five qualified candidates
9 submitted for consideration by the state fire council, subject
10 to the advice and consent of the senate; provided that the
11 director of transportation shall give strong consideration and
12 prioritize the five qualified candidates submitted by the state
13 fire council.

14 (b) Each appointed fire chief of the Hawaii state aircraft
15 rescue fire fighting unit of the airports division of the
16 department of transportation shall serve a term of four years.



1 No fire chief shall be appointed to more than two consecutive
2 terms."

3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
