### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, in Hawaii, there 2 are gaps in specialty care, especially in endocrinology, rheumatology, gastroenterology, and behavioral health. 3 Specialists and patients utilize costly travel to and from the 4 5 Honolulu urban hub to provide and receive specialty care. 6 The legislature further finds that there are programs that provide medical education and help to improve healthcare 7 delivery to underserved and remote areas. One such program is 8 9 Project Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes (ECHO). 10 Project ECHO is a hub and spoke model that been able to achieve outcomes at primary care sites equal to those at academic 11 12 medical centers for complex conditions such as hepatitis and 13 diabetes. Utilizing ongoing telemonitoring, primary care 14 clinicians who participate through Project ECHO develop 15 expertise in complex disease management and become recognized 16 within their communities as local resources for patients 17 requiring specialized care.
