A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE COMPUTER LANGUAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that while no other state
2 has established an official computer language, Hawaii recognizes
3 the significant role that computer science, software
4 development, and other STEM-related fields play in fostering
5 innovation, economic development, and educational advancement.
6 By designating an official computer language, Hawaii seeks to
7 raise awareness and encourage participation in these fields,
8 especially by the youth of the State.

9 The legislature further finds that while other computer
10 languages may merit consideration, Python, a universally adopted
11 programming language, has become integral to modern
12 technological innovation. The legislature recognizes that
13 Python is widely used in diverse applications such as artificial
14 intelligence, machine learning, data analytics, web development,
15 and chatbot programming. Its versatility, readability, and
16 accessibility make it an ideal tool for teaching coding and



1 developing software, even for those with no prior programming
2 experience.

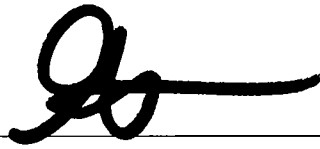
3 Designating Python as the first official computer language
4 of Hawaii will create new avenues for learning and inspire youth
5 to explore careers in computer sciences and related disciplines.
6 Additionally, this recognition will provide increased publicity
7 for technology enterprises in the State and position Hawaii as a
8 forward-thinking leader in technology education and innovation.
9 By embracing Python, Hawaii underscores its commitment to
10 equipping residents with the skills and knowledge necessary to
11 thrive in the 21st-century economy.

12 SECTION 2. Chapter 5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
13 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
14 read as follows:

15 "§5- State computer language. Python is adopted,
16 established, and designated as the official computer language of
17 the State."

18 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
