A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 287-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) The traffic and emergency period violations bureaus
- 4 of the district courts, upon request, shall furnish any person a
- 5 certified abstract of the bureaus' record, if any, of any person
- 6 relating to all [alleged moving violations and any convictions
- 7 resulting therefrom, moving violations resulting in convictions
- 8 arising from the operation of a motor vehicle and any
- 9 administrative license revocation pursuant to chapter 291E, part
- 10 III and chapter 286, part XIV, as it was in effect on or before
- 11 December 31, 2001. The traffic and emergency period violations
- 12 bureaus may collect a fee, not to exceed \$20, of which \$18 shall
- 13 be deposited into the general fund and \$2 shall be deposited
- 14 into the judiciary computer system special fund."
- SECTION 2. By July 1, 2026, the traffic and emergency
- 16 period violations bureaus of the district courts shall remove
- 17 all dismissed moving violations that did not result in a

- 1 conviction arising from the operation of a motor vehicle from
- 2 the certified abstract of all persons.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2026-2027 for the traffic and emergency period violations
- 8 bureaus of the district courts to remove all dismissed moving
- 9 violations not resulting in convictions from all traffic
- 10 abstracts.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
- 12 for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.
- 18 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Moving Violations; Traffic Abstract; Appropriations

Description:

Limits moving violations arising from the operation of a motor vehicle that appear on traffic abstracts to those that resulted in convictions. Requires the Traffic and Emergency Period Violations Bureaus to remove all dismissed moving violations not resulting in a conviction from certified abstracts. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
