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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST  
ITEMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for  
3 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII  
4 of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

5 PART II

6 SECTION 2. There are appropriated or authorized from the  
7 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining  
8 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2023-2025 all  
10 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated  
11 with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining  
12 units (1), (2), (3), (4), (8), (9), (10), (13), and (14) and  
13 their excluded counterparts. The amounts are for a negotiated  
14 settlement for the executive branch and the university of  
15 Hawaii, and an arbitration award for the department of



1 education. These amounts are in addition to the amounts  
2 provided in Act 49, Session Laws of Hawaii 2024:

SECTION 3. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part shall be allotted by the director of finance to the appropriate state departments for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for the purposes of this part.

PART III

SECTION 4. There are appropriated or authorized from the sources of funding indicated below to judiciary administration (JUD 601) the following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund for fiscal year 2024-2025 all collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining units (1), (2), (3), (4), (8), (9), (10), and (13):

SECTION 5. Funds appropriate or authorized by this part shall be expended by the chief justice in the respective fiscal year for the purposes of this part.

PART IV

SECTION 6. There are appropriated or authorized from the source of funding indicated below to Hawaii health systems



corporation - corporate office (HTH 210) the following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund for fiscal year 2024-2025 the collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining units (1), (2), (3), (4), (8), (9), (10), and (13) and their excluded counterparts:

SECTION 7. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part shall be allotted by the director of finance to the Hawaii health systems corporation for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for the purposes of this part.

PART V

SECTION 8. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be, from the respective funds.

SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any provision of this Act, with the approval of the governor, the director of finance may



1 transfer between parts II and IV of this Act the unrequired  
2 balances as may be available from the appropriated funds of  
3 parts II and IV of this Act as necessary.

4 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act  
5 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2025, shall  
6 lapse as of that date.

7 SECTION 11. In accordance with section 9 of article VII  
8 of the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,  
9 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that  
10 the appropriations from previous years have caused the state  
11 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be  
12 exceeded by \$8,551,796 or one per cent. In addition, the  
13 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund  
14 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further  
15 exceeded by \$ or one per cent. The reasons for  
16 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that:

- 17 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to  
18 serve the public interest; and  
19 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs  
20 addressed by this Act.

21 SECTION 12. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

**Description:**

Makes emergency appropriations for collective bargaining cost items for the members of Units (1), (2), (3), (4), (8), (9), (10), (13), and (14) and their excluded counterparts, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining unit representative for fiscal year 2024-2025. Declares that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 has been exceeded. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
