
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State offers a
2 unique opportunity for job growth and economic development
3 through its important geographic location. During fiscal year
4 2022, the State received almost \$9 billion in defense spending.
5 Furthermore, from fiscal years 2018 to 2022, the number of
6 defense-related jobs increased by about ten thousand. Many of
7 these jobs are in the areas of information technology,
8 cybersecurity, intelligence, and data science, providing
9 good-paying jobs for the State's local economy. To meet the
10 growing demand for jobs in these fields, the State should
11 utilize and invest in the expertise offered at the college of
12 social sciences at the university of Hawaii at Manoa and the
13 business administration program at the university of Hawaii,
14 West Oahu campus.

15 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
16 funds to the university of Hawaii to hire faculty at the college
17 of social sciences at the university of Hawaii at Manoa and at



1 the business administration program at the university of Hawaii,
2 West Oahu's campus for workforce development to support the
3 defense sector of the State's economy.

4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
7 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
8 year 2026-2027 for the establishment of the following positions:

9 (1) Two full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE) assistant
10 professors in international economics, trade, and
11 security;

12 (2) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) professor of
13 practice in intelligence studies;

14 (3) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) educational
15 specialist; and

16 (4) One half-time equivalent (0.5 FTE) graduate research
17 assistant,

18 in the college of social sciences at the university of Hawaii at
19 Manoa for workforce development in the defense sector of the
20 State's economy.



1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the university
2 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
7 year 2026-2027 for student housing, travel costs, material
8 supplies, and operation of the academy for Hawaii intelligence
9 studies summer program of the college of social sciences at the
10 university of Hawaii at Manoa to develop a pipeline of talented
11 students for workforce development in the defense sector of the
12 State's economy.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the university
14 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
18 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
19 year 2026-2027 for the establishment of the following positions:

20 (1) One half-time equivalent (0.5 FTE) faculty for the
21 director of the cybersecurity coordination center; and



1 (2) One half-time equivalent (0.5 FTE) faculty for the
2 director of the cybersecurity research laboratory,
3 for the business administration program at the university of
4 Hawaii, West Oahu campus for workforce development in the
5 defense sector of the State's economy.

6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the university
7 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
12 year 2026-2027 for student internship programs, certifications,
13 software, and other related expenses for the business
14 administration program at the university of Hawaii, West Oahu
15 campus for workforce development in the defense sector of the
16 State's economy.

17 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the university
18 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 31, 2050.
