# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NEPOTISM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes the importance of  
2 maintaining transparency, accountability, and fairness in  
3 government operations, including within its own ranks. While  
4 existing laws prohibit most state employees from hiring or  
5 supervising relatives or awarding contracts to businesses owned  
6 by relatives or household members, these provisions do not  
7 currently extend to employees of the legislature.

8       Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to subject  
9 legislative employees to the same ethical standards as other  
10 state employees, effectively preventing nepotism in the  
11 legislative branch. Through this Act, the legislature reaffirms  
12 its commitment to upholding the highest standards of integrity  
13 and fostering public trust in government operations.


14       SECTION 2. Section 84-13.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
15 amended by amending subsection (i) to read as follows:



1        "(i) Notwithstanding sections 84-2 and 84-3, this section  
2 shall not apply to employees or agencies of the [~~legislative or~~]  
3 judicial branch of the State."

4        SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken.

6        SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
