A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FITNESS TO PROCEED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of corrections and
- 2 rehabilitation shall establish a five-year fitness to proceed
- 3 pilot program in one county of the State to help reduce
- 4 overcrowding at the Hawaii state hospital and ensure the safety
- 5 of the hospital's staff and personnel while an inmate is
- 6 awaiting a determination on the inmate's fitness to proceed
- 7 pursuant to chapter 704, Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided that
- 8 the county in which the pilot program is established has a
- 9 population of more than two hundred thousand but less than five
- 10 hundred thousand.
- 11 (b) For purposes of the pilot program, the department of
- 12 corrections and rehabilitation shall reserve at least one cell
- 13 or personal living space to accommodate every two inmates who
- 14 have filed a motion or cited a defense pursuant to chapter 704,
- 15 Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 16 (c) An inmate housed in a reserved cell or living space
- 17 shall be in the primary custody of the department of corrections



- 1 and rehabilitation and receive mental health services through a
- 2 partnership with the department of health until a determination
- 3 is made regarding the inmate's fitness to proceed pursuant to
- 4 chapter 704, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 5 For the purposes of this subsection, the department of
- 6 corrections and rehabilitation shall have primary physical
- 7 custody of an inmate in the pilot program, and the department of
- 8 health shall be a partnering agency to provide mental health
- 9 services for the inmate.
- 10 (d) The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall
- 11 submit an interim report to the legislature on the status of the
- 12 pilot program no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 13 of the regular session of 2027 and a final report of its
- 14 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 15 legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 16 the regular session of 2030.
- 17 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 20 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

- 1 2026-2027 for the establishment and implementation of the
- 2 fitness to proceed pilot program.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of corrections and rehabilitation for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
