A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FITNESS TO PROCEED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of corrections and
- 2 rehabilitation shall establish a five-year fitness to proceed
- 3 pilot program to help reduce overcrowding at the Hawaii state
- 4 hospital and ensure the safety of the hospital's staff and
- 5 personnel while an inmate is awaiting a determination on the
- 6 inmate's fitness to proceed pursuant to chapter 704, Hawaii
- 7 Revised Statutes.
- **8** (b) For purposes of the pilot program, the department of
- 9 corrections and rehabilitation shall reserve at least one cell
- 10 or personal living space to accommodate every two inmates who
- 11 have filed a motion or cited a defense pursuant to chapter 704,
- 12 Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- (c) An inmate housed in a reserved cell or living space
- 14 shall be the joint responsibility of the department of
- 15 corrections and rehabilitation and department of health until a
- 16 determination is made regarding the inmate's fitness to proceed
- 17 pursuant to chapter 704, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

- 1 (d) The department of corrections and rehabilitation shall
- 2 submit an interim report to the legislature on the status of the
- 3 pilot program no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 4 of the regular session of 2027 and a final report of its
- 5 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 6 legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 7 the regular session of 2030.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 11 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 12 2026-2027 for the establishment and implementation of the
- 13 fitness to proceed pilot program.
- 14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 15 of corrections and rehabilitation for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2077.
