A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY CHARTER AIR SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that access to emergency
 air transportation is critical to ensuring public safety and
 responding effectively to urgent situations. In cases where no
 other air services are available, the lack of a dependable
 charter air service can impede disaster response, public safety
 operations, and essential state functions.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the air
carrier commission to enter into a contract with a qualified
charter air service provider to secure emergency air
transportation services.

SECTION 2. Chapter 261E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

14 "<u>\$261E-</u> <u>Emergency charter air services.</u> (a) The
15 <u>commission shall enter into a contract with a qualified charter</u>
16 air service provider to ensure the availability of emergency air

3	(b)	The contract shall require the qualified charter air
4	service provider to:	
5	(1)	Provide services within twenty-four hours of receiving
6		notice from the commission;
7	(2)	Provide a minimum of five flights per month for

9	(3)	Maintain all certifications, licenses, and insurance
10		required by state and federal law.
11	<u>(c)</u>	Any department or agency of the State may utilize the
12	qualified	charter air service provider for emergency air
13	transport	ation. Any department or agency utilizing the charter
14	air service provider shall reimburse the commission for the cost	
15	of the flight services, as determined by the terms of the	
16	contract.	
17	(d)	The commission shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
18	<u>91 necess</u>	ary to carry out the purposes of this section,
19	including	but not limited to the procedures for requesting and
20	reimbursi	ng the costs of charter air services."



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1	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so		
3	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and		
4	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal		
5	year 2026-2027 for the air carrier commission to enter into a		
6	contract with a qualified charter air service provider to		
7	provide emergency air transportation in accordance with		
8	section 2 of this Act.		
9	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department		
10	of transportation for the purposes of this Act.		
11	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.		
12	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
