### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAZARD PAY BONUS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART 1
2	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that certain state
3	employees faced a heightened risk of exposure to coronavirus
4	disease 2019 during the pandemic due to the nature of their work
5	and the need for their consistent in-person presence. These
6	employees, including those in bargaining units 5, 6, and 7,
7	provided essential services to the public, often in challenging
8	and potentially hazardous environments. Their dedication and
9	sacrifice helped to maintain critical functions of the State and
10	ensured the well-being of Hawaii's residents.
11	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to award a one-time
12	hazard pay bonus in recognition of and as compensation for the
13	extraordinary services provided by the members of bargaining
14	units 5, 6, and 7, and their exclusive counterparts during the
15	pandemic. This Act serves as a token of appreciation for their
16	commitment and acknowledges the risks they undertook to fulfill
17	their duties.
