A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the illegal use,
- 2 possession, and distribution of fireworks continue to endanger
- 3 public safety, property, and the environment in the State.
- 4 Despite existing laws and enforcement efforts, the unauthorized
- use of fireworks persists, causing disturbances and posing 5
- significant risks to residents.
- 7 On June 7, 2023, the governor signed Act 67, Session Laws
- 8 of Hawaii 2023, into law, establishing an illegal fireworks task
- 9 force within the department of law enforcement. The illegal
- 10 fireworks task force was required to develop a comprehensive
- 11 strategic plan to address the systemic problem of illegal
- 12 firework trade and usage within the State. The illegal
- 13 fireworks task force submitted a final report to the
- 14 thirty-third legislature containing the task force's findings,
- 15 recommendations, and proposed legislation, which included a
- recommendation that the legislature fund a new crime unit within 16



- 1 the department of law enforcement to address illegal fireworks
- 2 enforcement on a full-time basis.
- 3 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish an
- 4 illegal fireworks enforcement division within the department of
- 5 law enforcement to enhance regulatory oversight, increase
- 6 enforcement, and further coordination among agencies to combat
- 7 illegal fireworks activities.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 10 and to read as follows:
- 11 "§353C- Illegal fireworks enforcement division. (a)
- 12 There shall be established within the department an illegal
- 13 fireworks enforcement division. The division shall use the
- 14 findings from the illegal fireworks task force established
- 15 pursuant to Act 67, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, as a basis for
- 16 developing a comprehensive strategic plan to stop the
- 17 importation and distribution of illegal fireworks and explosives
- 18 in the State, promote compliance with the state fireworks
- 19 control laws, and ensure the safety and security of critical
- 20 infrastructure against the discharge of illegal fireworks.

•	(b) An administrator sharr be the head of the firegar
2	fireworks enforcement division and shall have charge, direction,
3	and control of the division and all matters relating to the
4	enforcement of illegal fireworks by the department, subject to
5	the direction and control of the director; provided that the
6	department and counties, or both, are authorized to enforce and
7	administer the provisions of chapter 132D pursuant to section
8	132D-20."
9	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
10	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
12	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13	year 2026-2027 to carry out the purposes of this Act, including:
14	(1) The operation of the illegal fireworks enforcement
15	division; and
16	(2) The reimbursement of funds to law enforcement agencies
17	for division-related law enforcement operations,
18	including law enforcement personnel, overtime and
19	other salary-related payments, charges for fuel,
20	equipment, technology, and storage and disposal of
21	confiscated fireworks.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- $\mathbf{6}$ the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2026-2027 for the establishment of six permanent positions
- 8 within the illegal fireworks enforcement division of the
- 9 department of law enforcement as follows:
- 10 (1) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) division
- administrator position;
- 12 (2) Four full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE) state law
- enforcement investigator positions; and
- 14 (3) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) clerk position,
- 15 who shall be exempt from chapter 76, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 17 of law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025, and
- 20 shall be repealed on June 30, 2028.
