RELATING TO PROPERTY DAMAGE OF CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

10	<u>(a)</u>	Recklessly or negligently causes damage in an amount

14	<u>(b)</u>	Knowingly uses a firearm, drone, or explosive weapon
15		in the commission of the offense and recklessly or

3	(2) Criminal property damage of a critical infrastructure		
4	facility in the first degree is a class A felony.		
5	§708-B Criminal property damage of a critical		
6	infrastructure facility in the second degree. (1) A person		
7	commits the offense of criminal property damage of a critical		
8	infrastructure facility in the second degree if the person		
9	intentionally or knowingly damages any critical infrastructure		
10	facility without the owner or operator's consent, and recklessly		
11	or negligently causes substantial impairment to the critical		
12	infrastructure facility.		
13	(2) Criminal property damage of a critical infrastructure		
14	facility in the second degree is a class B felony."		
15	SECTION 2. Section 708-800, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
16	amended by adding five new definitions to be appropriately		
17	inserted and to read as follows:		
18	""Critical infrastructure facility" has the same meaning as		
19	"critical infrastructure" defined in section 708-890; provided		
20	that for sections 708-A and 708-B "critical infrastructure		
21	facility" shall include broadband and cable television networks.		

1	"Drone" means an unmanned aircraft, watercraft, or ground		
2	vehicle or a robotic device that is controlled remotely by a		
3	human operator or operates autonomously through computer		
4	software or other programming.		
5	"Explosive weapon" means any explosive or incendiary device		
6	that is designed, made, or adapted for the purpose of inflicting		
7	serious bodily injury, death, or substantial property damage, or		
8	for the principal purpose of causing such a loud report as to		
9	cause undue public alarm or terror. "Explosive weapon"		
10	includes:		
11	(1) An explosive or incendiary bomb, grenade, rocket, and		
12	mine;		
13	(2) A device designed, made, or adapted for delivering or		
14	shooting an explosive weapon; and		
15	(3) A device designed, made, or adapted to start a fire in		
16	a time-delayed manner.		
17	"Firearm" has the same meaning as defined in section 134-1.		
18	"Substantial impairment" means impairment of a critical		
19	infrastructure facility that:		
20	(1) Lasts for two hours or more; or		

- 1 (2) Affects one thousand or more retail customers of the
- 2 affected critical infrastructure facility."
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 4. In codifying the new sections added by
- 7 section 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 8 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 9 the new sections in this Act.
- 10 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
