A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SIXTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$17,700,000 or so much
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
sixteenth senatorial district, as follows:

1. Aiea Elementary School

A. Design and construction for new
multipurpose covered play court,
including storage room and
restrooms; equipment and
appurtenances.

2. Aiea High School



1 A. Plans, design, and construction
2 for new visitor bleachers for
3 outdoor track and field.
4 Total funding \$600,000

5 B. Plans and design for the athletics
6 department weightroom.

10 Total funding \$200,000

11 3. Webling Elementary School

12 A. Plans, design, and construction
13 for a new main office building;
14 equipment and appurtenances.
15 Total funding \$10,000,000

16 4. Department of Transportation

17 A. Plans and design for an emergency
18 egress/ingress route for Pacific
19 Palisades.
20 Total funding \$1,000,000



1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
8 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

9 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 3 shall be
10 expended by the department of education; and

11 (2) The sum appropriated in item 4 shall be expended by
12 the department of transportation.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
