A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, until June 30,
- 2 2020, Act 124, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, authorized the
- 3 department of education to award high school diplomas to
- 4 qualified persons who did not receive a high school diploma as a
- 5 result of compulsory induction into active service in the armed
- 6 services of the United States or any person whose high school
- 7 education was interrupted due to wartime practices such as
- 8 internment during World War II.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of
- 10 education to award high school diplomas to a qualified person
- 11 who did not receive a high school diploma as a result of
- 12 compulsory or voluntary induction into active service in the
- 13 armed services of the United States or whose high school
- 14 education was interrupted due to wartime practices during World
- 15 War II, the Korean War, or the Vietnam War.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended b	by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3	designate	ed and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§</u> 30	2A- High school diploma for armed services veterans
5	and other	qualified persons. (a) The department is authorized
6	to establ	ish a program to award a high school diploma to any
7	qualified person who:	
8	(1)	Did not receive a high school diploma as a result of
9		compulsory or voluntary induction into active service
10		in the armed services of the United States during
11		World War II, the Korean War, or the Vietnam War; or
12	(2)	Did not receive a high school diploma and whose high
13		school education was interrupted due to wartime
14		practices during World War II, the Korean War, or the
15		<u>Vietnam War.</u>
16	(b)	A qualified person seeking a high school diploma shall
17	submit in	formation establishing eligibility for the award of a
18	high school diploma pursuant to subsection (a) to the department	
19	on forms prescribed by the department.	
20	<u>(c)</u>	For purposes of this section, a "qualified person"
21	means any	individual who:

1	<u>(1)</u>	Was a resident of the State or the Territory of Hawaii
2		and was compulsorily or voluntarily inducted into the
3		armed services of the United States or whose high
4		school education was interrupted between:
5		(A) December 1, 1941, and August 30, 1945;
6		(B) June 1, 1950, and July 31, 1953; or
7		(C) August 1, 1964, and January 31, 1973;
8		while enrolled in a high school in the State or the
9		Territory of Hawaii; and
10	(2)	Did not complete a high school curriculum and receive
11		a high school diploma."
12	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
