# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1.   Section 132-16.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2   amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3       "(a)   There is established the office of the state fire  
4   marshal within the department of labor and industrial relations.  
5   The office shall be headed by a state fire marshal, who shall be  
6   appointed by the state fire council to serve for a term of five  
7   years.   No person shall serve as state fire marshal for more  
8   than three terms.   The appointment of the state fire marshal  
9   shall be made without regard to chapters 76 and 89, and shall  
10   not be subject to the advice and consent of the senate.   In the  
11   event of a vacancy, the state fire council shall meet  
12   expeditiously to select and appoint a new state fire marshal to  
13   serve the remainder of the unexpired term.   The state fire  
14   marshal may hire staff as necessary."

15       SECTION 2.   New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
