BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part III, subpart C, to be		
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>\$302A-</u> Future career and technical education teacher		
5	scholarship program; established. (a) There is established the		
6	future career and technical education teacher scholarship		
7	program to be administered by the department to facilitate the		
8	recruitment and retention of career and technical education		
9	teachers.		
10	(b) An individual shall be eligible for scholarship		
11	consideration if the individual:		
12	(1) Is enrolled at a university of Hawaii campus and		
13	qualifies for Hawaii resident tuition under		
14	section 304A-402; and		
15	(2) Is enrolled in a state-approved teacher education		
16	program at the university of Hawaii.

1 (e) Moneys repaid by scholarship recipients pursuant to 2 subsection (d) shall be deposited into the general fund. 3 (f) The board may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to 4 implement and administer the program." 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and 8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 9 year 2026-2027 for the future career and technical education 10 teacher scholarship program. 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 12 of education for the purposes of this Act. 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored. 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
