2	shall be subject to the payment of premiums determined under
3	this subsection. The department shall:
4	(1) Establish sliding-scale premiums that are based on
5	countable income, with a minimum premium of \$20 per
6	month and a maximum premium of \$250 per month; and
7	(2) By rule, annually adjust the premiums.
8	Before adjustment of any premiums determined pursuant to this
9	subsection, the department shall submit a report of proposed
10	premium adjustments to the legislature no later than twenty days
