A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The auditor shall conduct a financial
- 2 audit of each charter school under the state public charter
- 3 school commission. For each charter school, the financial audit
- 4 shall include:
- 5 (1) A list of financial expenditures for the past three
- 6 years;
- 7 (2) Financial information concerning faculty; and
- **8** (3) The school's cash on hand balance.
- 9 (b) The auditor shall submit a report of its findings and
- 10 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 11 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 12 the regular session of 2026.
- SECTION 2. No later than one year after the auditor's
- 14 submission of the report to the legislature under section 1 of
- 15 this Act, the state public charter school commission shall take
- 16 action based on the recommendations made by the auditor.

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 5 2026-2027 for the auditor to complete the financial audit
- 6 pursuant to section 1 of this Act.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the auditor for
- 8 the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
