A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL WORKFORCE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ion 1. (a) There is established within the department
2	of agricul	ture for administrative purposes an agricultural
3	workforce	housing working group to address the shortage and
4	challenges	s of agricultural workforce housing in the State.
5	(b)	The working group shall comprise the following members
6	or their o	designees:
7	(1)	The governor;
8	(2)	The chairperson of the board of agriculture, who shall
9		serve as co-chair of the working group;
10	(3)	The chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission;
11	(4)	The chairperson of the agribusiness development
12		corporation, who shall serve as co-chair of the
13		working group;
14	(5)	The executive director of the Hawaii housing finance
15		and development corporation;
16	(6)	The executive director of the Hawaii public housing
17		authority;

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ı	(/)	The chairperson of the land use commission;
2	(8)	The director of the office of planning and sustainable
3		development;
4	(9)	The chief engineer of the engineering division of the
5		department of land and natural resources;
6	(10)	The mayor of each county;
7	(11)	The director of each county planning department;
8	(12)	The director of each county housing department; and
9	(13)	The chief engineer of each county board of water
10		supply.
11	(c)	The co-chairs of the working group shall invite one
12	represent	ative from each of the following organizations to
13	participa	te as a member of the working group:
14	(1)	Hawaii Agricultural Foundation;
15	(2)	Hawaii Agriculture Research Center;
16	(3)	Hawaii Farm Bureau; and
17	(4)	Hawaii Farmers Union United.
18	(d)	The co-chairs of the working group may invite other
19	individua	ls with relevant knowledge and expertise to serve as

1	(e)	No member shall be made subject to chapter 84, Hawaii
2	Revised S	tatutes, solely because of that member's participation
3	as a memb	er of the working group.
4	(f)	The department of agriculture is requested to provide
5	administr	ative support to the working group.
6	(g)	The working group shall:
7	(1)	Determine:
8		(A) The specific housing needs of each agricultural
9		workforce within each county; and
10		(B) Existing government resources available for
11		adaptive reuse into agricultural workforce
12		housing;
13	(2)	Assess existing laws, policies, and procedures that
14		would allow the construction of workforce housing:
15		(A) Near agricultural zones; or
16		(B) With agricultural facilities in mixed-use
17		developmental zones;
18	(3)	Consider any revisions necessary to existing zoning
19		and land use policies that would allow the
20		construction of workforce housing:
21		(A) Near agricultural zones; or

1		(B) With agricultural facilities in mixed-use
2		developmental zones;
3	(4)	Explore partnerships with private and public entities
4		to construct agricultural workforce housing projects;
5	(5)	Identify any financial incentives, such as tax credit
6		programs for agricultural employers who invest in
7		housing solutions for their workforce, that would
8		support the construction of agricultural workforce
9		housing projects in the State; and
10	(6)	Study the feasibility of implementing a state income
11		tax credit to investors who incur costs to construct,
12		install, acquire, or rehabilitate agricultural
13		workforce housing in the State.
14	(h)	The working group shall submit an interim report of
15	its progr	ess, including any proposed legislation, to the
16	legislatu	re no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
17	the regul	ar session of 2027, and submit a final report of its
18	findings	and recommendations, including any proposed
19	legislati	on, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
20	to the co	nvening of the regular session of 2028.
21	(i)	The working group shall be dissolved on June 30, 2028.

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$800,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 5 2026-2027 for the agricultural workforce housing working group
- 6 established in section 1 of this Act to gather the necessary
- 7 data and prepare the required reports, including any
- 8 consultation fees and related expenses.
- 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 10 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
