A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that increasing local
2 agricultural production is essential to the long-term
3 sustainability and food security of the State. However, local
4 agricultural producers face significant economic challenges,
5 particularly with the high costs of transporting agricultural
6 products and necessary supplies across the State. In a recent
7 survey report on Hawaii commercial agricultural expansion,
8 thirty-nine per cent of local ranchers and farmers cited
9 shipping and transportation costs as a leading barrier to the
10 expansion of their agricultural production. These
11 transportation costs place undue strain and financial burdens on
12 farmers and ranchers, limiting their ability to compete in local
13 markets and reducing the overall productivity of Hawaii's
14 agricultural sector.

15 The legislature recognizes that, to successfully scale up
16 local production, the establishment of a cost reimbursement
17 program that offsets the increased transportation costs of



1 agricultural producers is necessary to ensure growth in the
2 agricultural sector. The financial relief provided by a cost
3 reimbursement program would help strengthen local agriculture,
4 encourage greater self-sufficiency, support the State's broader
5 efforts to diversify its economy, and promote sustainable
6 agricultural practices.

7 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to ensure that
8 certain local agricultural producers, particularly those that
9 manage livestock and produce essential commodities, receive
10 support to offset the high costs of transporting goods to market
11 and to obtain necessary supplies by establishing a local
12 agriculture transportation cost reimbursement program.

13 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
15 and to read as follows:

16 **"§141- Local agriculture transportation cost**
17 **reimbursement program; rules.** (a) There is established within
18 the department of agriculture a local agriculture transportation
19 cost reimbursement program to reimburse eligible agricultural
20 producers for a portion of the producer's costs to transport
21 agricultural commodities.



1 (b) To be eligible to receive reimbursement payments
2 pursuant to this section, an agricultural producer shall:

3 (1) Be an owner of livestock or a producer of agricultural
4 commodities in the State;

5 (2) Incur costs for transporting in a covered motor
6 vehicle or through air cargo, parcel, or water cargo
7 carrier services:

8 (A) Livestock, livestock products, or agricultural
9 commodities to market within the State; or

10 (B) Supplies for the use of the agricultural
11 producer; and

12 (3) Provide to the department of agriculture proof that
13 the agricultural producer has annual gross receipts
14 totaling \$ or more.

15 (c) The total amount of reimbursement payments disbursed
16 pursuant to this section shall not exceed \$ in any
17 year.

18 (d) The department may establish rules pursuant to
19 chapter 91 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section.

20 (e) For purposes of this section:



1 "Agricultural commodity" has the same meaning as in section
2 145-21.

3 "Covered motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle:

4 (1) Registered and owned by an owner of livestock or a
5 producer of agricultural commodities in the State; and

6 (2) Used for the transport of livestock, livestock
7 products, agricultural commodities, and supplies
8 within the State."

9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
12 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2026-2027 for the department of agriculture to fund and
14 administer the local agriculture transportation cost
15 reimbursement program established pursuant to this Act.

16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
17 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
21 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal



1 year 2026-2027 to establish and fund one full-time equivalent
2 (1.0 FTE) position within the department of agriculture to
3 administer the reimbursement local agriculture transportation
4 cost reimbursement program established pursuant to this Act.

5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
6 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.

DOA; Transportation Costs; Shipping Costs; Reimbursements;

Description:

Establishes a Local Agriculture Transportation Cost Reimbursement Program within the Department of Agriculture to reimburse eligible ranchers and farmers a portion of their costs to transport livestock, livestock products, agricultural commodities, and certain supplies, under certain conditions. Establishes a position to administer the Program. Makes appropriations.
