A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that increasing local 2 agricultural production is essential to the long-term 3 sustainability and food security of the State. However, local 4 agricultural producers face significant economic challenges, 5 particularly with the high costs of transporting agricultural 6 products and necessary supplies across the State. In a recent 7 survey report on Hawaii commercial agricultural expansion, 8 thirty-nine per cent of local ranchers and farmers cited 9 shipping and transportation costs as a leading barrier to the 10 expansion of their agricultural production. These 11 transportation costs place undue strain and financial burdens on 12 farmers and ranchers, limiting their ability to compete in local 13 markets and reducing the overall productivity of Hawaii's 14 agricultural sector.

15 The legislature recognizes that, to successfully scale up 16 local production, the establishment of a cost reimbursement 17 program that offsets the increased transportation costs of

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1 agricultural producers is necessary to ensure growth in the 2 agricultural sector. The financial relief provided by a cost 3 reimbursement program would help strengthen local agriculture, 4 encourage greater self-sufficiency, support the State's broader 5 efforts to diversify its economy, and promote sustainable 6 agricultural practices.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to ensure that
certain local agricultural producers, including those that
manage livestock and produce essential commodities and those
engaged in floriculture and nursery production, receive support
to offset the high costs of transporting goods to market and to
obtain necessary supplies by establishing a local agriculture
transportation cost reimbursement program.

SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

17 "<u>§141-</u> Local agriculture transportation cost

18 reimbursement program; rules. (a) There is established within
19 the department of agriculture a local agriculture transportation
20 cost reimbursement program to reimburse eligible agricultural



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1	producers	for a portion of the producer's costs to transport
2	<u>agricultu</u>	ral commodities.
3	(b)	To be eligible to receive reimbursement payments
4	pursuant	to this section, an agricultural producer shall:
5	(1)	Be an owner of livestock or a producer of agricultural
6		commodities in the State, a cooperative aggregator or
7		food hub, or a start-up or small-scale farmer
8		demonstrating commercial intent that earns below the
9		threshold of gross receipts under paragraph (3);
10	(2)	Incur costs for transporting in a covered motor
11		vehicle or through air cargo, parcel, or water cargo
12		carrier services:
13		(A) Livestock, livestock products, or agricultural
14		commodities to market within the State; or
15		(B) Supplies for the use of the agricultural
16		producer; and
17	(3)	Provide to the department of agriculture proof that
18		the agricultural producer has annual gross receipts
19		totaling \$ or more.
20	(c)	The total amount of reimbursement payments disbursed
21	pursuant	to this section shall not exceed \$ in any



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1	year; provided that no single producer shall receive more than
2	\$25,000 or fifty per cent of their eligible transportation costs
3	per fiscal year, whichever is less; provided further that no
4	single cooperative aggregator or food hub shall receive more
5	than \$50,000 or fifty per cent of their eligible transportation
6	costs per fiscal year, whichever is less.
7	(d) The department shall submit an annual report to the
8	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
9	each regular session. The report shall include:
10	(1) The total number of producers reimbursed;
11	(2) The total amount of funds disbursed; and
12	(3) Any recommendations for improvements or modifications
13	to the program.
14	(e) The department may establish rules pursuant to
15	chapter 91 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section.
16	(f) For purposes of this section:
17	"Agricultural commodity" has the same meaning as in section
18	145-21, including nursery production.
19	"Covered motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle:
20	(1) Registered and owned by an owner of livestock or a
21	producer of agricultural commodities in the State; and

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1	(2) Used for the transport of livestock, livestock
2	products, agricultural commodities, and supplies
3	within the State."
4	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
5	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
6	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
7	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
8	year 2026-2027 for the department of agriculture to fund and
9	administer the local agriculture transportation cost
10	reimbursement program established pursuant to this Act.
11	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
12	of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
13	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
14	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
15	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
16	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17	year 2026-2027 to establish and fund one full-time equivalent
18	(1.0 FTE) position within the department of agriculture to
19	administer the local agriculture transportation cost
20	reimbursement program established pursuant to this Act.

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1	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2	of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
3	SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
4	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
