## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that over the past four
 decades, the value of all agricultural products in the State has
 been in decline. Investing in the State's agricultural data and
 statistics gathering system is a necessary and critical
 component to the revitalization and future of Hawaii's
 agricultural sector.

7 The legislature further finds that utilizing modern data 8 and statistics gathering methodologies can promote access to 9 high-quality data, which can then be used to help empower 10 policymakers and agricultural stakeholders in making informed 11 decisions and supporting sustainable farming practices. 12 Improving the technical, data-gathering component of the 13 department of agriculture is necessary to provide the State and 14 its farmers with the ability to track and anticipate patterns of 15 agricultural activity, guide land use practices, support 16 commodity investment and agricultural resource development, and 17 inform future infrastructure investments.



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Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
 funds to the department of agriculture to conduct a study of
 agricultural markets for Hawaii farmers and to establish
 positions to conduct and collect relevant agricultural data for
 public consumption.

6 SECTION 2. (a) The department of agriculture shall
7 conduct a study on agricultural markets for Hawaii farmers,
8 which shall include strategies and actions that support
9 agriculture and a robust agricultural sector in the State.

10 (b) The department of agriculture shall submit a report of
11 its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
12 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
13 to the convening of the regular session of 2026.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 for a one-year study of agricultural markets for Hawaii farmers.

18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 19 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

20 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
