A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§356D- Expenditures of the public housing special fund
5	exempt from appropriation and allotment. Except as to
6	administrative expenditures, and except as otherwise provided by
7	law, expenditures from the public housing special fund
8	administered by the authority under section 356D-28 may be made
9	by the authority without appropriation or allotment by the
10	legislature; provided that no expenditure shall be made from and
11	no obligation shall be incurred against the public housing
12	special fund in excess of the amount standing to the credit of
13	the fund or for any purpose for which the fund may not lawfully
14	be expended. Nothing in sections 37-31 to 37-41 shall require
15	the proceeds of the public housing special fund identified in
16	section 356D-28 to be reappropriated annually."

10		moneys deposited in depositories other than the state
11		treasury under section 40-81, and rules adopted
12		thereunder; and
13	(3)	The authority shall submit an annual report to the
14		legislature on all <u>authority</u> program areas <u>and funds</u>
15		organized by program area, and by fund within each
16		program area, no later than twenty days prior to the
17		convening of each regular session, that shall provide
18		the following information on the status of its
19		programs and finances:
20		(A) A description of programs being developed in the
21		current fiscal biennium, including a summary

(E) Recommendations with reference to any 1 [(B)] 2 additional legislation or other action that may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this 3 chapter." 4 SECTION 4. Section 356D-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 7 "§356D-28 Public housing special fund. (a) There is established the public housing special fund to be administered 8 9 by the authority. Notwithstanding section 36-21, the proceeds in the fund shall be used for long-term and other special 10 11 financings of the authority, the development and redevelopment of authority projects, and for necessary expenses in 12 13 administering this chapter. 14 (b) All moneys received and collected by the authority, including moneys received and collected by an agent authorized 15 pursuant to section 356D-10 and moneys received and collected 16 pursuant to a partnership or development agreement authorized 17 pursuant to section 356D-12.5, and all moneys not otherwise 18 19 pledged, obligated, or required by law to be placed in any other 20 special fund, shall be deposited into the public housing special fund." 21

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SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun before its effective date.
SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
