1	SECTION 1. Chapter 102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§102- Naming rights of state-owned facilities;</u>
5	marketing; advertising. (a) The naming rights for any state-
6	owned facility may be sold or leased to any public or private
7	entity.
8	(b) Any revenues derived from advertising or marketing in
9	or on any state-owned facility, including revenues derived under
10	subsection (a), shall be deposited into the appropriate special
11	fund of the state agency that owns the facility or into the
12	general fund if no appropriate special fund exists."
