## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TIP CREDIT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§387-2 Minimum wages[-]; tip credit. (a) Except as 4 provided in section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall 5 pay to each employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate 6 of not less than: 7 (1)\$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 8 (2) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; 9 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007; 10 (4)\$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 11 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 12 (6) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; 13 (7) \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018; 14 \$12.00 per hour beginning October 1, 2022; (8) 15 \$14.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2024; (9) 16 \$16.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2026; and (10)17 \$18.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2028. - 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
