SECTION 1. Section 89-10.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as
follows:

(a) 5 A public employer shall enter into written agreement with the 6 exclusive representative setting forth a grievance procedure 7 culminating in a final and binding decision, to be invoked in 8 the event of any dispute concerning the interpretation or 9 application of a written agreement. The grievance procedure 10 shall be valid and enforceable and shall be consistent with the 11 following:
