A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii's natural
- 2 resources are among the State's most precious assets. These
- 3 resources are vital to the strength of Hawaii's environment,
- 4 economy, and cultural heritage. Effective conservation
- 5 enforcement is critical to safeguard these resources from
- 6 unlawful exploitation and degradation.
- 7 The legislature further finds that the department of land
- 8 and natural resources' DLNRTip application provides an important
- 9 mechanism for citizens to report natural resource violations
- 10 directly to the department of land and natural resources.
- 11 However, the legislature also finds that the application has
- 12 faced challenges due to inconsistent monitoring, which has led
- 13 to delayed or no responses, the loss of critical evidence, and a
- 14 decline in public trust. These shortcomings have hindered the
- 15 application's ability to function as an effective enforcement
- 16 tool.



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- 1 The legislature recognizes the increasing demand for 2 citizen involvement in conservation enforcement. Given the 3 extensive scope of natural resource protection and the 4 limitations of available enforcement personnel, citizen 5 reporting is essential for bridging enforcement gaps. 6 To address these issues, this Act codifies the DLNRTip 7 application into the Hawaii Revised Statutes and provides 8 critical resources to increase the application's effectiveness. 9 This change will help to ensure that the department of land and 10 natural resources properly monitors the application and responds 11 to reports in a timely fashion. The resources provided by this 12 Act will also help to enhance the application's capabilities, 13 establish dedicated staffing, and mandate comprehensive 14 reporting to the legislature on the application's use and 15 effectiveness.

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20 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:

1	(1)	Establish the DENRTIP application as the official
2		electronic platform for persons to report natural

5	(2)	Establish statutory requirements regarding the design
6		and maintenance of the DLNRTip application;
7	(3)	Require the department of land and natural resources
8		to ensure that all information submitted through the
9		DLNRTip application is continuously monitored to
10		facilitate timely enforcement responses;
11	(4)	Require annual reports to the legislature on the use
12		and effectiveness of the DLNRTip application; and
13	(5)	Appropriate moneys to implement and maintain the
14		DLNRTip application and to establish one full-time
15		equivalent (1.0 FTE) position to support the operation
16		of the DLNRTip application.

18		proposed legislation."

20	amended b	y designating sections 199-1 to 199-9 as part I,
21	entitled	"General Provisions".

12		(B)	Monitor incoming reports submitted using the

1	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2	of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
3	SECTION 5. If any provision of this Act, or the
4	application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held
5	invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
6	applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
7	invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
8	of this Act are severable.
9	SECTION 6. In codifying the new sections added by section
10	2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
11	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
12	the new sections in this Act.
13	SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.

Report Title:

DLNR; DLNRTip; DOCARE; Mobile Application; Conservation Enforcement; Appropriations

Description:

Establishes the DLNRTip application as the official electronic platform for persons to report natural resource violations to the Division of Conservation and Resources Enforcement. Creates statutory requirements regarding the design and maintenance of the DLNRTip application. Require the Department of Land and Natural Resources to ensure that all information submitted through the DLNRTip application is continuously monitored to facilitate timely enforcement responses. Requires annual reports. Authorizes 1.0 full-time equivalent position. Appropriates moneys.

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
