A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GUN VIOLENCE PREVENTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by 2 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read 3 as follows: 4 "CHAPTER 5 OFFICE OF GUN VIOLENCE PREVENTION § -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter: 6 7 "Director" means the director of the office of gun violence 8 prevention. "Office" means the office of gun violence prevention. 9 -2 Office of qun violence prevention; established. 10 There is established within the department of law 11 enforcement, for administrative purposes only, an office of gun 12 13 violence prevention. 14 (b) The head of the office of gun violence prevention
- shall be known as the director of the office of gun violence 15
- prevention and shall be appointed by the governor pursuant to 16
- 17 section 26-34.



1	(c)	The director shall be responsible for:
2	(1)	Serving as the principal officer in state government
3		responsible for the performance, development, and
4		control of programs, policies, and activities under
5		the jurisdiction of the office;
6	(2)	Administering funds allocated for the office and
7		applying for, receiving, and disbursing grants and
8		donations from all sources for gun violence
9		prevention;
10	(3)	Assessing the policies and practices of other state
11		and county agencies relating to gun violence
12		prevention; and
13	(4)	Advising state and county agencies on new legislation,
14		programs, and policy initiatives relating to gun
15		violence prevention.
16	(d)	The office of gun violence prevention shall:
17	(1)	Conduct public awareness campaigns in a culturally
18		appropriate manner to educate Hawaii residents about
19		state and federal laws and existing resources relating
20		to gun violence prevention, including but not limited
21		to:

I		(A)	Sale and responsible gun ownership;
2		(B)	Reporting of lost or stolen firearms, including
3			any state reporting requirements;
4		(C)	Best practices for safe storage of firearms;
5		(D)	Filing and obtaining orders of protection; and
6		(E)	Accessing available mental health and substance
7			use resources;
8	(2)	Admi	nister a grant program for organizations to
9		cond	uct community-based gun violence intervention
10		init	iatives focused on interrupting cycles of gun
11		viol	ence, trauma, and retaliation that are evidence-
12		info	rmed and have demonstrated promise at reducing gun
13		viol	ence without contributing to mass incarceration;
14	(3)	Crea	te and maintain a resource bank as a repository
15		for	data, research, and statistical information
16		rega	rding gun violence in Hawaii; and
17	(4)	Deve	lop a plan to address gun violence in Hawaii and
18		coor	dinate, improve, and expand upon existing plans
19		for	gun violence prevention.
20	(e)	The	office may collaborate with any other state or
21	county age	ency ·	to fulfill the purposes of this chapter.



- 1 § -3 Grant program. (a) There is established a gun
- violence prevention grant program to be developed and
- 3 administered by the office of gun violence prevention. Subject
- 4 to availability of funds, the office shall award grants to
- 5 organizations to conduct community-based gun violence
- 6 intervention initiatives.
- 7 (b) The office shall develop criteria for the awarding of
- 8 grants and shall establish standards, policies, and procedures
- 9 for the administration of the gun violence prevention grant
- 10 program.
- 11 § 4 Gun violence prevention special fund. (a) There
- 12 is established in the state treasury the gun violence prevention
- 13 special fund, to be administered by the office of gun violence
- 14 prevention, into which shall be deposited all moneys received by
- 15 the office in the form of:
- **16** (1) Grants;
- 17 (2) Donations; and
- 18 (3) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund.
- 19 (b) The office shall submit an annual report to the
- 20 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of

8	(b)	As part of maintaining the resource bank, the office
9	shall:	
10	(1)	Assist researchers who are seeking information about
11		gun violence in the State;
12	(2)	Collaborate with researchers, including organizations
13		that conduct gun violence research, to:
14	,	(A) Identify gaps in available data needed for gun
15		violence prevention research and develop
16		strategies to improve relevant data collection
17		the State;
18		(B) Use existing available research to enhance
19		evidence-based gun violence prevention tools and
20		resources available to communities in the State;

and

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1	(C) Improve the understanding of the disproportionate
2	barriers to safety from gun violence by
3	encouraging disaggregation of data by race and
4	ethnicity when research id conducted; and
5	(3) Promote new and relevant research regarding gun
6	violence prevention and, if possible, make this
7	research accessible to researchers and the public.
8	§ -6 Reporting. The office shall submit an annual
9	report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
10	convening of each regular session that contains a summary of its
11	activities during the preceding year, including:
12	(1) Grants awarded;
13	(2) The office's engagement with community entities and
14	other stakeholders; and
15	(3) Any other findings and recommendations, including any
16	proposed legislation.
17	§ -7 Rules. The office shall adopt rules pursuant to
18	chapter 91 to carry out the purposes of this chapter."
19	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
20	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
21	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and

- 1 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 2 year 2026-2027 to be deposited into the gun violence prevention
- 3 special fund.
- 4 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the gun violence
- 5 prevention special fund the sum of \$ or so much
- 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 7 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 8 2026-2027 for the awarding of grants to organizations to conduct
- 9 community-based gun violence intervention initiatives.
- 10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 11 qun violence prevention for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 16 2026-2027 for the purposes of this Act, including the hiring of
- 17 personnel and the establishment of a gun violence resource bank.
- 18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 19 qun violence prevention for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
