A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OUT-OF-STATE OFFICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that enhancing economic
- 2 ties between Hawaii and the Philippines presents significant
- 3 opportunities for strengthening mutual economic development.
- 4 Filipinos have emerged as the second-largest ethnic group in
- 5 Hawaii, representing approximately twenty-five per cent of
- 6 Hawaii's population, and play major roles in all sectors of
- 7 Hawaii's economy. In addition, President Ferdinand R. Marcos,
- 8 Jr. has recently emphasized the potential for expanding trade
- 9 cooperation between the Philippines and Hawaii. Assisting small
- 10 businesses in developing and marketing products, focusing on
- 11 strengthening economic development, expanding and diversifying
- 12 trade opportunities, promoting cultural exchanges, and
- 13 leveraging the Filipino community in Hawaii can enhance the
- 14 economic and cultural partnerships between Hawaii and the
- 15 Philippines and lead to sustained growth and mutual benefits.

- 1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 2 department of business, economic development, and tourism to
- 3 establish an out-of-state office in the Philippines.
- 4 SECTION 2. The department of business, economic
- 5 development, and tourism shall establish an out-of-state office
- 6 in the Philippines pursuant to section 201-81, Hawaii Revised
- 7 Statutes.
- **8** SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 12 year 2026-2027 for the department of business, economic
- 13 development, and tourism to establish an out-of-state office in
- 14 the Philippines.
- 15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 16 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
- 17 of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
