A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IMMIGRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 207, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2024, established an immigration services and
- 3 access unit within the office of community services to assist
- 4 the office in achieving its mandate of serving low-income
- 5 individuals, immigrants, and refugees. As the State is
- 6 comprised of a significant immigrant population and families
- 7 with mixed immigration statuses, providing additional support
- 8 for immigrants will ensure timely access to services and minimal
- 9 disruption to the lives of individuals who have pending
- 10 immigration proceedings.
- 11 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to establish an
- 12 immigration services trust fund to provide continued support to
- 13 the office of community services for immigration-related
- 14 matters.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 371K, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 17 and to read as follows:
