A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a critical
- 2 shortage of qualified English language learner educators in the
- 3 State. This shortage has a detrimental impact on the education
- 4 of students whose primary language is not English. To address
- 5 this shortage and improve student outcomes, it is necessary to
- 6 develop incentives to attract and retain qualified educators for
- 7 the English language learner program to ensure that English
- 8 language learners receive the support they need to succeed
- 9 academically and reach their full potential. Providing a pay
- 10 differential to English language learner educators is a proven
- 11 strategy to incentivize skilled professionals to enter and
- 12 remain in the profession.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to require and fund pay
- 14 differentials for English learner educators.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 17 and to read as follows:



I	"§302A- Differential pay for English learner educators.
2	(a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the
3	department shall pay a differential to any educator who provides
4	direct services to English language learners and:
5	(1) Holds a valid license to teach English to speakers of
6	other languages with an endorsement in teaching
7	English as a second language; or
8	(2) Meets the equivalent requirement as determined by the
9	department.
10	(b) The amount of the pay differential shall be
11	<u>\$</u> "
12	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
13	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
14	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
15	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
16	year 2026-2027 to fund pay differentials for English language
17	educators.
18	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
19	of education for the purposes of this Act; provided that the
20	sums appropriated shall not be released until a memorandum of
21	understanding is executed between the superintendent of

- 1 education and the exclusive representative of collective
- 2 bargaining unit (5).
- 3 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
