A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIFTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$38,700,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 fifteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Moanalua High School

8 A. Plans, design, and construction
9 for new weight room; equipment and
10 appurtenances.

11 Plans and design \$3,000,000

12 Construction \$16,000,000

13 Equipment \$1,000,000

14 Total funding \$20,000,000

SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.


SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective

expended for the purposes of this Act by the department of
education.
