BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§70</u>	6- Sentencing of imprisonment for sexual assault.
5	Notwithst	anding any provision of chapter 706 to the contrary, a
6	person co	nvicted of an offense under section 707-730, 707-731,
7	707-732,	707-733, or 707-733.6 shall be sentenced to a mandatory
8	minimum t	erm of imprisonment without possibility of parole or
9	probation	as follows:
10	(1)	For sexual assault in the first degree under section
11		707-730, years;
12	(2)	For sexual assault in the second degree under section
13		707-731, years;
14	(3)	For sexual assault in the third degree under section
15		707-732, year;
16	(4)	For sexual assault in the fourth degree under section
17		707-733, months; and

1	(5) For continuous sexual assault of a minor under the age
2	of fourteen years under section 707-733.6, years."
3	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5	begun before its effective date.
6	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
