## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

## REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO DESIGNATE KALAELOA AIRPORT AS THE ABIGAIL K.K. KAWANANAKOA AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, Kalaeloa Airport began operations in the 1940s, 1 providing aviation services for both civilian and military uses; 2 3 and 4 WHEREAS, authority over the Kalaeloa Airport was 5 transferred to the State in July 1999 to provide for the needs 6 of Hawaii's general aviation community; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the Kalaeloa Airport has been utilized for housing 9 United States Coast Guard Operations and as a training facility 10 for future pilots and flight schools throughout the State; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the late Abigail Kinoiki Kekaulike Kawananakoa, a 13 distinguished descendant of the Kalakaua dynasty of Hawaiian 14 royalty, and the grandniece of Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole 15 and great granddaughter of James Campbell spent much of her life 16 and money in support of the preservation of a Native Hawaiian 17 identity through its cultural practices, language, and history, 18 including but not limited to the annual Merrie Monarch Festival 19 hula festival, Aha Punana Leo Hawaiian Language Revitalization 20 Program, and Iolani Palace; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the Kalaeloa Airport is in the ahupuaa o 23 Honouliuli, the largest on the island of Oahu, and an expansive, 24 rich landscape, which is the modern day home to the James 25 Campbell Industrial Park, the city of Kapolei, and James 26 Campbell High School, which reflect the legacy, vision, and work 27 of Miss Kawananakoa's great grandfather and Scottish 28 Industrialist James Campbell; and 29 30 WHEREAS, the ahupuaa o Honouliuli also contains the home of 31 the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, which is the legacy of 32

1 Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole while he served as the State's 2 Delegate to the United States Congress; and 3 WHEREAS, renaming the Kalaeloa Airport as the Abigail K.K. 4 Kawananakoa Airport is consistent and appropriate given her 5 6 direct lineage to both James Campbell and Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole, and the consistency of her ohana's presence and 7 historical positive impact on ahupuaa o Honouliuli where many 8 9 landmarks and structures bear the names of her direct descendants; and 10 i 11 WHEREAS, the State should acknowledge, honor, and preserve 12 the legacy of Abigail Kinoiki Kekaulike Kawananakoa, and the 13 14 many philanthropic endeavors she pursued in support of Native Hawaiians and the maintenance of a Hawaiian cultural identity; 15 16 now, therefore, 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 18 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the 19 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 20 Transportation is requested to designate Kalaeloa Airport as the 21 Abigail K.K. Kawananakoa Airport; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 24 25 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the United States Secretary of Transportation, Administrator of the Federal 26 Aviation Administration, Governor, Director of Transportation, 27 28 Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, and Director of the City and County of Honolulu Department of Design and 29 30 Construction. . 1 31 32 33 OFFERED BY: By Request
