SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES AND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO INCENTIVIZE COMMUNITY CARE FOSTER FAMILY HOMES IN THE STATE TO ACCEPT INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THE STATE'S MEDICAID I/DD WAIVER PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, a Community Care Foster Family Home (CCFFH) is a 1 2 home that is regulated and certified by the Department of Health to provide, for a fee, twenty-four-hour living accommodations, 3 4 including personal care and homemaker services, to certain individuals who need nursing facility level of care; and 5 6 7 WHEREAS, CCFFH is a more affordable alternative to 8 institutionalized care, such as intermediate care facilities or skilled nursing facilities, enabling individuals to receive care 9 and support in their own homes and communities; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, Medicaid is a jointly funded, federal-state health insurance program for individuals with limited income and 13 resources who meet eligibility requirements; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the State's Medicaid program, also known as Med-16 QUEST, is administered by the Med-Quest Division of the 17 Department of Human Services; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Medicaid's Home- and Community-Based Services 20 (HCBS) waiver program, established pursuant to section 1915(c) 21 22 of the federal Social Security Act, allows states to waive certain Medicaid requirements to provide medical assistance to 23 eligible individuals in the form of reimbursing HCBS providers 24 for part or all of the costs for their services; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, the Med-Quest Division works in partnership with the Developmental Disabilities Division of the Department of 28 Health to design and implement the State's HCBS waiver program 29



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(Medicaid I/DD waiver program) that meets the needs of its 1 2 residents with intellectual or developmental disabilities; and 3 4 WHEREAS, there is an insufficient number of CCFFHs in the State that accept individuals eligible for assistance under the 5 State's Medicaid I/DD waiver program; now, therefore, 6 7 8 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 9 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 10 Human Services and Department of Health are requested to 11 12 establish a program to incentivize Community Care Foster Family Homes in the State to accept individuals who are eligible for 13 14 assistance pursuant to the State's Medicaid I/DD waiver program; 15 and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Human 18 Services and Director of Health. 19 20 21 22 OFFERED B
