SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO COMPLETE THE
CONSTRUCTION OF THE WAIANAE POLICE STATION.

1 WHEREAS, the Waianae Police Station officially opened on
2 May 20, 2016; and
3

4 WHEREAS, more than sixteen million dollars were dedicated
5 to creating the new police substation, which includes sixteen
6 holding cells, more than sixty parking stalls, a ninety-foot
7 radio tower, and a full-service receiving desk; and
8

9 WHEREAS, while the physical structure exists, the
10 substation is not fully functional due to unfinished
11 infrastructure; and
12

13 WHEREAS, an additional six million dollars is needed to
14 install the necessary infrastructure for the substation to be
15 completely operational; and
16

17 WHEREAS, the substation has been underutilized for
18 approximately ten years, and crime in West Oahu has increased;
19 and

21 WHEREAS, although violent crime rates on Oahu have trended
22 downward, parts of West Oahu experienced substantial increases
23 in homicides during 2023 and 2024; and
24

25 WHEREAS, more than half of the homicides on Oahu during
26 this period occurred in Honolulu Police Department District
27 Eight, which includes the entirety of West Oahu, by October
28 2024; and

30 WHEREAS, in response to the surge in homicides, the Mayor
31 of the City and County of Honolulu and the Honolulu Police Chief
32 pledged additional law enforcement resources to the West Oahu
33 area; now, therefore,

2 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third
3 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the
4 House of Representatives concurring, that the City and County of
5 Honolulu is urged to complete the construction of the Waianae
6 Police Station; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
9 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
10 and County of Honolulu, Managing Director of the City and County
11 of Honolulu, and Chief of the Honolulu Police Department.
